

2018 Federal Poverty Guidelines

The federal poverty guidelines are updated each year by the Department of Health and Human Services. These guidelines were updated 3/9/18 for the purpose of determining eligibility for Ryan White programs, including LA HAP.

LA HAP determines eligibility based on [Modified Adjusted Gross Income](#) (MAGI).

For LA HAP eligibility, [household](#) is based on your tax filing status.
