

ASSISTER TIPS TO KEEPING CLIENTS INSURED

Year-round

- **Notify LA HAP of updated information:** changes in address, income, premium amounts, insurance type, etc. should be reported to LA HAP as soon as possible.
- 2023 premiums cannot be paid until a 2023 invoice is on file at HIP
- Newly completed <u>Employer Insurance HR forms</u> are needed for each employer insurance open enrollment period. These forms must be completed by the employer to accept HIP payment for reimbursement (this period varies between employers).
- Employer Insurance HR forms are verified by HIP with HR before payments are issued.
- Clients are responsible for late enrollment penalties payments. How to avoid the penalty.
- Maintain a list of clients with no health insurance to help enroll in health insurance during Open Enrollment (November 1st – January 15th)

October

- Begin outreach to uninsured clients to prepare them for Open Enrollment in November.
- Medicare open enrollment begins 10/15/22
- Clients with Medicare premiums should receive a notice about their new upcoming premium amount to submit to LA HAP.

November

- Open Enrollment for 2023 Marketplace health insurance begins 11/1/22
- Continue to submit updated premium invoices or statements for clients
- If an insurance broker is used: follow up with insurance broker to see if client has been contacted and enrolled into a policy
- Send in an Insurance add/change form and invoice to LA HAP for the new policy information

<u>December</u>

- Medicare Open Enrollment ends 12/7/22
- Continue to submit updated premium invoices or statements for clients

January

- Medicare Part C Open Enrollment begins 1/1/23
- Marketplace Open Enrollment ends 1/15/23
- Continue to submit updated premium invoices or statements for clients

February

- Continue to submit updated premium invoices or statements for clients
- Medicare clients are at risk of losing insurance coverage if an invoice is not submitted and paid by the end of February (especially SilverScript clients)
