

# LA HAP gets clients COVERED!

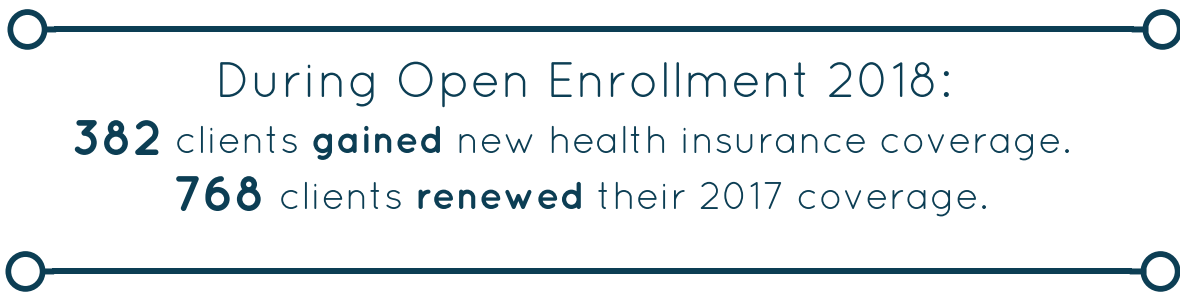
## What is LA HAP?

The **Louisiana Health Access Program** (LA HAP) provides persons living with HIV access to medications and assistance in paying for health insurance costs.



## What is Open Enrollment?

The period of time each year people can sign up for or change their health insurance on the Marketplace. Open Enrollment for 2018 ran from **November 1st to December 15th, 2017**.



During Open Enrollment 2018:

**382** clients **gained** new health insurance coverage.

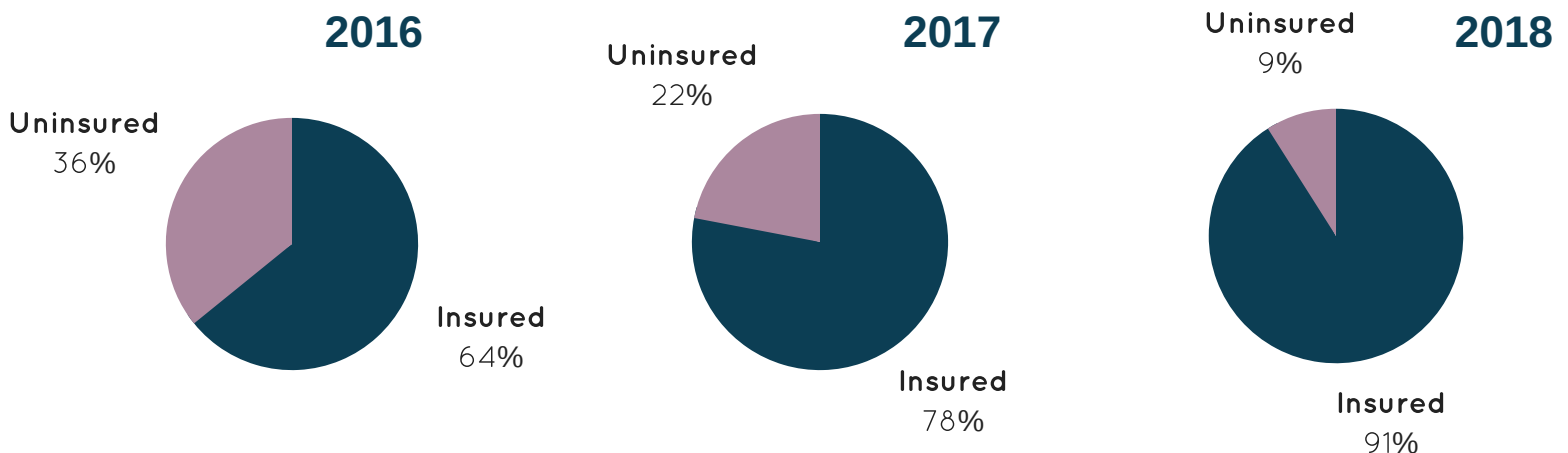
**768** clients **renewed** their 2017 coverage.

## Why does it matter?

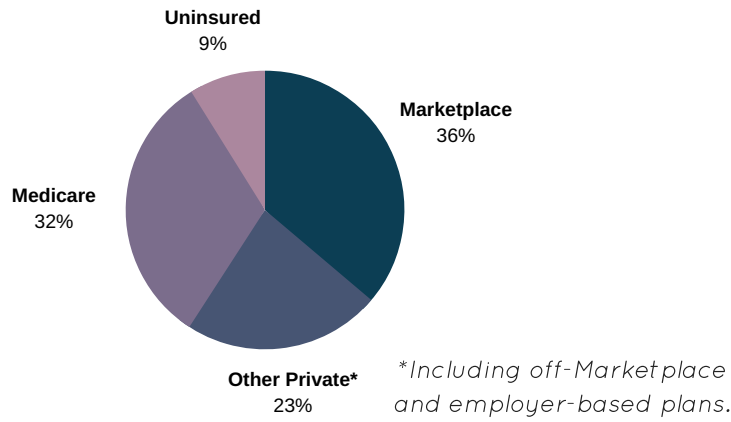
**88%** of consistently insured LA HAP clients are virally suppressed, compared with **74%** of uninsured clients.

LA HAP clients accounted for **1% (1,150 / 109,885)** of all Louisianans on the 2018 Marketplace.

The LA HAP uninsured rate has dropped **75%** over the last 3 years.



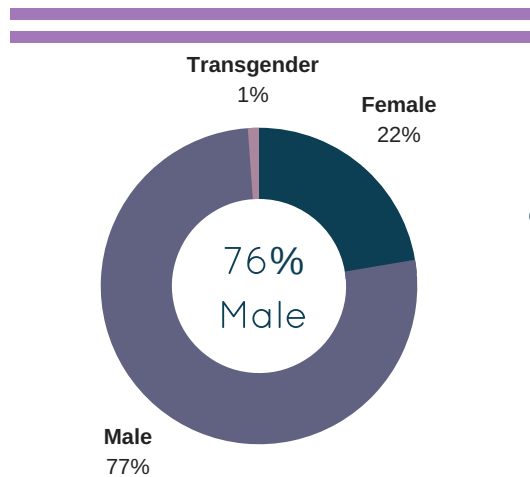
# What type of health insurance do LA HAP clients have?



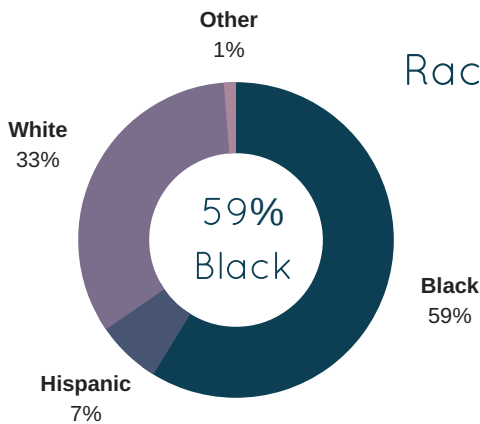
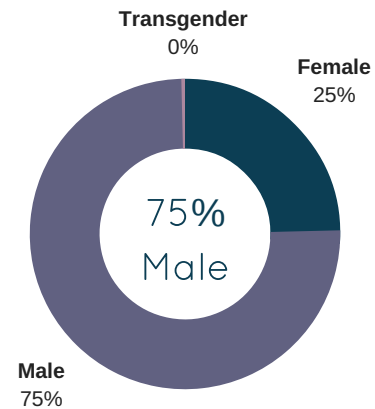
LA HAP also purchased 2018 **dental** coverage for **1,179** clients.

# How do LA HAP clients differ based on insurance status?

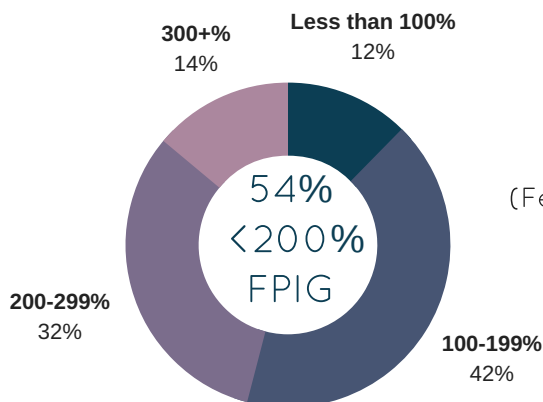
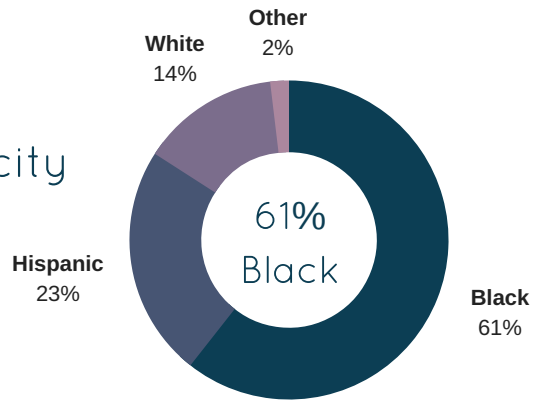

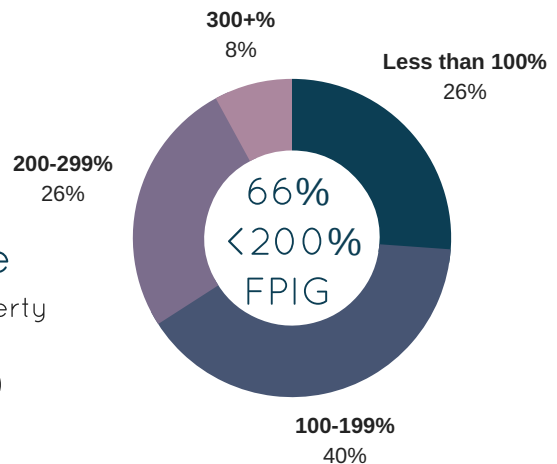
Gender
